GENERAL NOTES

- 92% OF ALL GOLF SHOTS LAND WITHIN A 15 DEG. ANGLE EITHER SIDE OF THE INTENDED PLAYLINE
- WHERE A BOUNDARY, PARTICULARLY A SENSITIVE ONE LIKE HOUSING PLOTS OR SURROUNDING ROADS ARE VISIBLE FROM THE TEE THE IMPACT ON A GOLFERS PSYCHOLOGY CAN BE QUITE EXTREME
- IF A SENSITIVE BOUNDARY COMES INTO PLAY ALLOWANCES BOTH IN TERMS OF ENLARGING THE MARGINS AS WELL AS PROVIDING SOME SOLUTIONS TO THE PROBLEM IN THE MID TO LONG TERM (ie PLANTING) SHOULD BE INCLUDED
- THE ORIENTATION OF TEES HAVE A DRAMATIC IMPACT ON A GOLFERS ALIGNMENT. A GOLFER HAS ONLY TO BE MISALIGNED BY 5 OR 6 DEG. FROM THE CENTRE OF THE FAIRWAY TO MISS ALTOGETHER A 40 MTR WIDE FAIRWAY
- THE ABOVE GUIDELINES HAVE BEEN EXTRACTED FROM THE EIGCA STANDARDS ON GOLF COURSE SAFETY MARGINS
